



Dear God...

I am always encouraged by how many people say that they pray.

According to a recent study over half of British adults pray sometimes, including a fifth of those who say they have no faith. Many people do not wish to be affiliated to a religion but retain a measure of spirituality.

The top reasons for praying, particularly among those who say they are not religious, are in times of personal or family crisis, the off chance that something might change, a last resort or to gain comfort or feel less lonely.

They are all good reasons for us to pray. Of course, there are many more too.

Praying when we need forgiveness or when we need to forgive somebody else. Praying when we are rejoicing or when life is really hard. Praying for strength, help or safety. Praying for wisdom or guidance, or for God to act in some particular way.

At the moment at All Hallows we are looking at some of the prayers people in the Bible prayed, and that includes all of these themes.



Sometimes when we want to pray something but just don't know what to say it can be helpful to read what somebody else going through a similar circumstance prayed.

We also regularly pray for those in particular need. Do let us know if you would like us to pray for you. There are prayer cards and a box in the church hall.
