One of the ways that we do that is at our **Breakfast at the Church**. This takes place on Tuesday mornings when the schools are in, from 8:00-10:00. A variety of breakfasts are available, and the cost is just £1 each.



We get a range of people coming, from school children before heading off to school, to parents coming back after the school run with their toddler children, to retired people who come a little bit later on their own, to other people and everybody else in between. This really is a place where different people gather together and where we can see community in action.

Breakfast at the Church is open to anybody who wishes to come and there is no need to book beforehand.

# New or Visiting?

## First Time Here?

If it's your first time here then welcome! It's great to have you with us. Here are a few short notes that you might find helpful.

**Relax** - You're our guest, so make yourself at home. If there is anything that you would like to know then ask a member of the Welcome Team.

**Sign the kids in** - The Welcome Team can show you where to take your children. Sometimes we are all in church together, but on other weeks... **Pre-School**; you choose! Either stay in the service (don't worry about noise) OR use our Crèche Room at the back of church. **Ages 3+**; Sunday School meet in rooms at the end of the hall, down the ramp. All leaders have proper DBS checks.

**Fill in a Communication Card** - Drop it in the box on the Welcome Desk in the foyer or give it to the service leader on the way out. Please use it to ask questions, offer feedback or request prayer.

**We don't expect guests to give** - For those who are members or regular attenders of our churches there is usually an offering, but we don't ask our guests for any money.

**We have a Loop System** - Switch your hearing aid to T-coil. You might find it useful to sit towards the middle.

**Hang around afterwards** - Come and join us for a cup of tea or fresh coffee, and for a chat.

**Prayer Ministry** - If you would like somebody to pray with you about something for yourself or somebody that you know then there are people who would love to do so after the service. Please make yourself known to the service leader

If you feel you've made a commitment to God but have never been baptised, then this could be a great step for you.


**JOIN A HOMEGROUP**
