We can often wrongly presume that other people know what we are talking about when we describe an upcoming event. That is not always right so here are some details about the different special events that are taking place during December.

Carols on the Green is outside the row of shops on Councillor Lane. Carol sheets are provided and we simply sing carols and some volunteers read the corresponding part of the nativity story.

We help to lead the special Carol singing event at **Ladybridge Park Residents Club** each year. This year it is on Tuesday 12th.

Messy Toddlers meets monthly, taking place during the Light Café. December 13th is our **Messy Toddlers Christmas Special**.

Sunday 17th sees our **Nativity Service** at 10:00 in the morning. The children in Sunday School have been planning a performance, but there is always a part for any children who turn up on the day and would like to join in. For our 6:30 evening service on 17th it is our **Carols by Candlelight** service. As always anybody and everybody are invited to these different services.

On Wednesday 20th at 1:00 we have our **Café Carol Service**. It is the same books and format as for Carols on the Green, but is in the warmth of the church lounge.

On Christmas Eve at 4:00 we have our **Christingle Service**. This is a fabulous way or bringing in Christmas for many people, young and old alike. We get lots of visitors and the Christingles are provided.

Finally, Christmas Day sees our **Family Celebration**, followed by Holy Communion for those who wants to stay on for that.

Blue Christmas

Over recent years we have held a Blue Christmas Service in church for those who like Christmas but struggle a bit at this time of year because of some changes that have taken place in their lives. We have found that the numbers physically attending have usually been low with considerably more online. 

New or Visiting?

First Time Here?

If it's your first time here then welcome! It's great to have you with us. Here are a few short notes that you might find helpful.

Relax - You're our guest, so make yourself at home. If there is anything that you would like to know then ask one of the Welcome Team by the front door.

We don't expect guests to give - For those who are members or regular attenders there is an offering plate at the back, but we don't ask our guests for any money.

We have a Loop System - Switch your hearing aid to T-coil. You might find it useful to sit towards the middle.

Hang around afterwards - Come and join us for a cup of tea or fresh coffee, and for a chat—drinks are served in the hall and we usually gather in the lounge to chat.

Prayer - If you would like someone to pray with you — either prayer for you or for someone you know — there are people who would love to do so after the service. Please make yourself known to the service leader.

Children & Youth - Once a month, the whole church worships together. On other weeks, there is a Sunday School for primary aged children and a group for high-school age young people. One of the Welcome Team can show you where these groups meet. For pre-school age children, there are green tables at the side of church with activities. Please don't be embarrassed if your children make any noise—they are welcome here and are part of the service, too! All our children and youth leaders have DBS checks and have undergone safeguarding training.

If you're not in one, there are a number of groups that meet in homes throughout the week to get to know each other better, look at the Bible and pray together.


BE PART OF THE MISSION
